Please also note the Final Checklist.

It is not clear at this time just when your article will appear in print. Before publication, you will receive your typeset manuscript from the managing editor for your review. Printing schedules require that you return the copy to the publisher within 48 hours of receipt. Please notify us immediately of any change in your address so that unnecessary delay can be avoided.

Also, we would like to post the original manuscript you submitted to NURSING RESEARCH on the NURSING RESEARCH Editor's Web site [<http://www.nursing-research-editor.com/authors/open.php>] simultaneously with the print publication of your article. The reviews on your manuscript were balanced and instructive. I am asking the permission of the reviewers to post their reviews of your manuscript, also.

The posting includes this introduction to readers: "At NURSING RESEARCH we are taking a first step in open peer review. If readers find this feature instructive we will expand it. Posting information on published manuscripts allows you to read the peer reviews, examine how manuscripts are revised based on them, and understand the contribution of the editorial office.
